## Failure to submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Repost (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUTINE (DPB), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The DOG RIDGE WSC water system PWS ID 0140044 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administration Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F.
